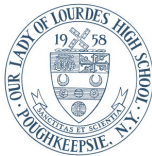

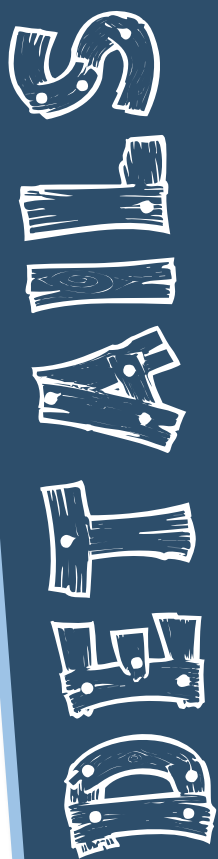

PURPOSE

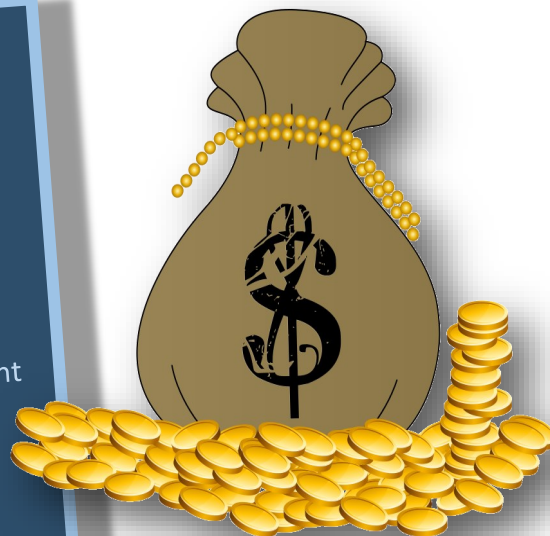
Our Lady of Lourdes High School offers nothing short of the best in college preparatory classes and activities. However, tuition alone does not cover the rising costs of providing the quality education for which we are known. Each year, we must close the near \$2,400 gap between tuition charged and our actual cost to educate each student.

Rather than impose a substantial tuition increase upon our families, Lourdes has implemented a mandatory fundraiser in the form of our "Blue & Gold Rush" raffle. All proceeds generated through the raffle are built directly into the school's operating budget; that provides critical funding for financial aid, technology upgrades, and facilities improvements; and greatly enhance the financial vitality of our school.

OVER



Single-student families are **required to raise a minimum of \$200**, while families with two or more students attending Lourdes are required to raise a **minimum of \$400**. Families may reach their mandatory fundraising quota by selling raffle tickets. **Raffle tickets sell for \$25 each**. Each family will receive raffle tickets worth their required quota. Additional raffle tickets may be obtained from the Advancement Office. Families may begin selling tickets immediately until October 2, 2018. Families that do not fulfill their minimum fundraising obligation will be billed through the Business Office for any remaining balance due (based on \$200 per student or \$400 per family). All unsold raffle tickets must be returned to avoid additional charges.



RAFFLE PRIZES

All individuals who purchase raffle tickets will have the chance to win **GREAT PRIZES!** The raffle drawing will take place on **Friday, October 5, 2018** during the school's **Homecoming Football Game!** (Winners need not be present).

INCENTIVES

The **ten top-selling families*** that surpass their quota by at least \$100 will be able to **earn up to \$1,000 or more in tuition credit!** Top seller prizes will be capped at \$5,000 and will be awarded in the form of tuition credit. If a family's account is paid in full, they will receive a check from the Business Office.

In addition, all families that exceed their fundraising quota by at least \$100 will **automatically receive an Ultimate Movie Pack from Regal Cinemas**. All **prizes and eligibility requirements**** are listed on the Blue & Gold Rush Raffle webpage (www.ollchs.org) and in the Prize & Incentive Information section of this guide.

All money must be received by 3pm on Tuesday, October 2 to qualify for incentive prizes. However, late money will be accepted through October 12 and applied toward a family's quota. Late money will not be considered when determining incentive prizes.

* Top seller prizes will be awarded to five single-student families and five multiple-student families.

PLEASE NOTE . . . Raffle tickets can be purchased using cash, check or money order (payable to Our Lady of Lourdes High School). Credit cards cannot be accepted. Must be 18 years of age or older to purchase raffle tickets.

PRIZE INCENTIVES

The **ten top-selling families*** that surpass their quota by at least \$100 will be able to **earn up to \$1,000 or more in tuition credit!** All money must be received by **3pm on Tuesday, October 2 to qualify for incentive prizes.** However, late money will be accepted through October 12 and applied toward a family's quota. Late money will not be considered when determining incentive prizes.

- In cases where the money raised is equal to or less than the prize value or if there is a tie, the prize value will automatically default to the designated percentage (i.e. If 3rd place winner raised \$500, their prize would be \$150).
- Top seller prizes will be capped at \$5,000 and will be awarded in the form of tuition credit. If a family's account is paid in full, they will receive a check from the Business Office for any overage.

Single Student Family Top Sales Prize Incentives

Highest Sales	\$1,000 (or) 50% of the total single student family sales—whichever is greatest •
2nd Highest Sales	\$750 (or) 40% of the total single student family sales—whichever is greatest •
3rd Highest Sales	\$500 (or) 30% of the total single student family sales—whichever is greatest •
4th Highest Sales	\$300 (or) 20% of the total single student family sales—whichever is greatest •
5th Highest Sales	\$200 (or) 10% of the total single student family sales—whichever is greatest •

Multiple Student Family Top Sales Prize Incentives

Highest Sales	\$1,000 (or) 50% of the total multiple student family sales—whichever is greatest •
2nd Highest Sales	\$750 (or) 40% of the total multiple student family sales—whichever is greatest •
3rd Highest Sales	\$500 (or) 30% of the total multiple student family sales—whichever is greatest •
4th Highest Sales	\$300 (or) 20% of the total multiple student family sales—whichever is greatest •
5th Highest Sales	\$200 (or) 10% of the total multiple student family sales—whichever is greatest •
